3. TIPS (The Interlocal Purchasing System) Board Resolution. Discussion by Board and staff. A motion was made and seconded to approve RES-002:

TIPS BOARD RESOLUTION

STATE OF TEXAS

FOR: THE REGION VIII EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of San Patricio Municipal Water District, San Patricio County, Texas, pursuant to the authority granted by TEX.GOV'T CODE §791.001, et seq, desires to participate in the TIPS Purchasing Cooperative offered by Region VIII Education Service Center, and in the Opinion that participating in this program will be highly beneficial to the

rate payers through the anticipated savings to be realized.

Therefore, be it **RESOLVED**, that the San Patricio Municipal Water District requests a stated need for participation in the Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) whereby the General Manager or his/her designee is authorized and directed to sign and deliver any and all necessary requests and documents in connection therewith for and on behalf of San Patricio Municipal Water District. I certify that the foregoing is a true and correct original Resolution duly adopted by the San Patricio Municipal Water District and is filed on record at the TIPS office. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Interlocal Agreement between Region 8 Education Service Center and the San Patricio Municipal Water District. Motion carried unanimously.

4. Two ½ Ton Pickup Trucks. Discussion by Board and staff. After the District officially joined the TIPS Interlocal Purchasing System, a motion was made and seconded to award a purchase for Lake County Chevrolet for two ½-ton pickup trucks for a total amount of \$87,159.00. Motion carried unanimously.

5. City of Corpus Christi's U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit Application No SWG-2014-00850 for the Inner Harbor Desalination Facilities. Discussion by Board and staff. A motion was made and seconded to approve RES-003:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Corpus Christi submitted an application to construct and operate desalination related facilities within the waters of the Inner Harbor to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE);

WHEREAS, the USACE has received and labeled the application as Permit Application No: SWG-2014-00850;

WHEREAS, The USACE has indicated they will receive public comments at their office on or before 16 February 2024;

WHEREAS, the City of Corpus Christi received water use permit no. 13676 from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on October 10, 2022 to utilize the waters of the Inner Harbor;

WHEREAS, the San Patricio Municipal Water District, established in 1951 by the Texas Legislature (52 nd session), receives its water supply from the City of Corpus Christi which acts as the regional developer and provider of water;

WHEREAS, the San Patricio Municipal Water District supplies potable water to nine municipalities (Aransas Pass, Gregory, Ingleside, Ingleside on the Bay, Odem, Portland, Rockport/Fulton, Taft, and jointly with City of Corpus Christi, Port Aransas) in three counties (San Patricio, Aransas and Nueces) which is used to meet the residential and commercial needs of customers in these municipal areas;

WHEREAS, the San Patricio Municipal Water District, also supplies potable water to Rincon Water Supply Corporation and Seaboard Water Supply Corporation;

WHEREAS, the San Patricio Municipal Water District, also supplies industrial process and untreated water to San Patricio industrial customers, which is critical to the economic viability of San Patricio County and the people living in it;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the San Patricio Municipal Water District is a seven member elected body with its members representing distinct geographic areas of San Patricio and Aransas County that roughly correspond with the municipalities served within and one appointed member that has historically represented industry;

WHEREAS, securing new water supplies that are sustainable, responsible, affordable, and drought resistant is critical to the future of this region in order to meet the needs of its current customers and allow for additional potable water to serve residential and commercial needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN PATRICIO MUNCIPAL WATER DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. The District supports all viable alternate water sources including, but not limited to this source, supported by the City of Corpus Christi's Inner Harbor submittal to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers entitled SWG-2014-00850 and requests this resolution be incorporated into the comments received by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers on or before 16 February 2024.

SECTION 2. The District further appreciates the work of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the City of Corpus Christi and stands ready to continue active participation in the efforts to enhance the water supply for this region.
