Black-Eyed Susan Rudbeckia hirta

- Annual 2 ft x 2 ft
- Sun/part sun
- Low water
- Blooms spring
- Salt tolerant
- Deer resistant
- Sand & clay soils on coast & E two-thirds of TX





Bluebonnets Lupinus texensis



- Annual $1 \text{ ft} \times 1 \text{ ft}$
- Sun
- Low water
- Blooms early spring
- Deer resistant
- Clay or sandy loam soils in C & S TX
- Sandyland bluebonnet is L. subcarnosus
- Texas Superstar



Drummond's Phlox

Phlox drummondii



- Annual 1 ft x 1 ft
- · Sun/part sun
- Low water
- Blooms spring
- Salt tolerant
- Sandy soils in SE TX



Greenthread

Thelesperma filifolium



- Annual 2 ft x 2-3 ft
- Full sun
- Very low water
- Blooms early spring-winter
- Deer resistant
- Salt tolerant
- On shell or sand on coast, SE & S



Horsemint

Monarda citriodora

- Annual 2 ft \times 2 ft
- Sun/part sun
- Low water
- Blooms spring
- · Salt tolerant
- Deer resistant
- Various soils in TX





Indian Blanket

Gaillardia pulchella

- Annual 1 ft x 2 ft
- · Sun/part sun
- · Low water
- · Blooms early spring-fall
- · Deer resistant
- · Very salt tolerant
- Shell & sandy prairies on coast & TX





Indian Paintbrush

- Annual 1 ft × 1 ft
- · Sun/part sun
- Very low water
- Blooms spring
- · Salt tolerant
- Native on sandy prairies on the coast & E half of TX





Lazy Daisy Aphanostephus skirrhobasis

- · Annual 1ft x 1ft
- · Sun/part sun
- · Low water
- Blooms springfall
- Very salt tolerant
- Native on sandy soils on coast & TX





Pentas, Egyptian Star Pentas lanceolata

- Annual up to 3 ft x 3 ft
- Sun
- · Low water
- Blooms spring-fall
- Native to Egypt





PeriwinkleCatharanthus roseus

- · Annual 2 ft x 2 ft
- · Sun/part shade
- · Very low water
- · Blooms spring-fall
- · Salt tolerant
- · Deer resistant
- Native to Madagascar



Plains Coreopsis Coreopsis tinctoria

Annual 3 ft x 1 ft

- Sun
- Low water
- Blooms springsummer
- Salt tolerant
- Deer resistant
- Native on various soils on coast & E half of TX
